Terms of Service

Last updated: June 21, 2026

These Terms of Service ("Terms") govern your use of the **Postalist** mobile application and related services (the "App"), operated by **Tristar Dynamics LLC** ("Tristar Dynamics," "we," "us," or "our"). By creating an account or using the App, you agree to these Terms. If you do not agree, do not use the App.

1 Eligibility

You must be at least 18 years old (or the age of majority where you live) and able to form a binding contract to use the App. By using the App you represent that you meet these requirements.

2 What Postalist does

Postalist provides personal pay-tracking and scheduling tools for U.S. Postal Service employees across the City Letter Carrier, Clerk, Mail Handler, and Rural Carrier crafts. The App generates estimates from information **you enter**. It is a personal planning tool only.

3 Your account

You are responsible for providing accurate information, keeping your password secure, and for all activity under your account. Notify us promptly at support@postalist.app if you suspect unauthorized use.

4 Subscriptions, billing, and trials

- Postalist is offered as a subscription at **\$3.99 per month** or **\$39.99 per year** (prices may vary by region and are subject to change with notice).
- New users may be offered a **14-day free trial**. Unless you cancel before the trial ends, it automatically converts to a paid subscription.
- Subscriptions are sold through the **Apple App Store**. **Apple is the merchant of record**; payment is charged to your Apple ID.
- Subscriptions **auto-renew** unless canceled at least 24 hours before the end of the current period. Manage or cancel anytime in **Settings > your Apple ID > Subscriptions**, or through the App Store app.
- Refunds are handled by Apple under the App Store's policies; we generally cannot issue refunds directly.

5 License

We grant you a limited, personal, non-exclusive, non-transferable, revocable license to use the App for your own personal, non-commercial use. You may not copy, modify, reverse-engineer, resell, scrape, or create derivative works from the App except as permitted by law.

6 Estimates and accuracy — please read

All pay, hours, schedule, non-scheduled-day, and countdown outputs in Postalist are **estimates for informational and personal-planning purposes only**, generated from the information you enter and from general assumptions about craft pay rules.

They are **not official USPS records**, are **not guaranteed to be accurate or current**, and are **not connected to LiteBlue, ePayroll, or any USPS or government system** — Postalist does not access your USPS accounts. References to contract provisions (for example, Article 8, NALC color rotations, or step schedules) are provided for convenience and may not reflect the current or applicable collective bargaining agreement.

Postalist does **not** provide financial, tax, legal, or employment advice. Always verify against your official USPS pay statements and your union or contract before relying on any figure.

7 No affiliation

Postalist and Tristar Dynamics LLC are not affiliated with, endorsed by, or sponsored by the United States Postal Service, the National Association of Letter Carriers (NALC), the American Postal Workers Union (APWU), the National Postal Mail Handlers Union (NPMHU), the National Rural Letter Carriers' Association (NRLCA), or any government agency or labor union. All trademarks belong to their respective owners.

8 Acceptable use

You agree not to misuse the App, interfere with its operation or security, attempt unauthorized access, or use it for any unlawful purpose.

The App, including its design, code, and content (excluding data you enter), is owned by Tristar Dynamics LLC and protected by intellectual-property laws. These Terms do not grant you any rights in our trademarks or branding.

We do not warrant that the App will be uninterrupted, error-free, or that any estimate will be accurate.

11 Limitation of liability

You may stop using the App and delete your account at any time. We may suspend or terminate access if you violate these Terms or to protect the service. Sections that by their nature should survive termination will survive.

14 Governing law and dispute resolution

These Terms are governed by the laws of the **State of New Jersey**, without regard to conflict-of-laws rules. You and Tristar Dynamics LLC agree to resolve any dispute through **binding individual arbitration** rather than in court, and you waive any right to participate in a class action, to the extent permitted by law. Any matter not subject to arbitration will be resolved exclusively in the state or federal courts located in **Bergen County, New Jersey**, and you consent to their jurisdiction.
